Please note that department representatives are responsible to check first aid kit inventory periodically and replace used or expired items.

Burn Treatment	10	1/32 oz
Cold Pack	1	4 x 5 in.
Eye Covering, with means of attachment	2	2.9 sq. in.
First Aid Guide	1	N/A
Hand Sanitizer	6	1/32 oz
Medical Exam Gloves	2 pair	Large
Roller Bandage	1	2 in. x 4 yd

Sterile pad	2	3 x 3 in.
Trauma pad	2	5 x 9 in.
Triangular Bandage	1	40 x 40 x 56 in.
