


PCI Training

To continue accepting credit/debit card payments, UCSD is required to comply with Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS). Compliance with the standards require annual training be completed by our staff, students and faculty who directly process or who supervise others who transmit, store or otherwise process credit/debit card payments. Training must be completed shortly after hire date and thereafter on an annual basis. An annual reminder of this training requirement will be sent to existing users one month before their annual due date through the UC Learning Center email alerts. The instructions below will assist new staff who have not yet been trained.


